Priced line by line

Every quote separates inclusions from exclusions. Where a drawing does not carry the detail to price an item, we raise it before submission rather than carry the risk into your program.

Documentation on schedule

Weld certificates, as-built drawings and compliance records are issued as the work completes, so your QA file closes without follow-up.

Scope we can hold

If a package sits outside our capability, or a date sits outside our capacity, we say so at tender stage. A declined job costs less than a delayed one.

One line of communication

Our estimating team prices the work and our director runs the crew. Both sit inside the business, so a question about the quote reaches the person who wrote it.

We work to your systems

Our crews operate under your site rules, inductions, permits and program, with our own supervision. Head contractors re-engage us because we do not create supervision work for them.

SWMS, JSAs, hot work permits and toolbox talks for every engagement. Incident-free since incorporation, with the records to show it.

Plant maintenance & fabrication support

Ongoing maintenance and fabrication support for **Hitachi** — hardfaced wear bars, track pad repairs, structural repair and fabricated access stairs and handrail fitted to earthmoving plant, in our workshop and on the client's floor.

Terminal maintenance & supplied crews

Ongoing supply of MSIC-carded welders and trade assistants to **Patrick Terminals** inside a working container terminal. Ship-to-shore crane welding, crack repairs with magnetic particle testing, hot work permits and terminal safety scrutiny as normal operating conditions.

Structural steel lift shaft fabricated in the workshop and erected on a live site for **Hall Group**, working to the building's as-built dimensions. Lift shafts leave no tolerance to play with — the steel lands where the lift engineer says it lands.

Structural steel shade cover and a steel-framed tiered seating structure for a working school, delivered as steel subcontractor to **FHS Builders**. Two scopes on one site, built and installed around term dates and student access.

Handrail, balustrade, welded mesh infill and gates to a hockey field, plus handrail and cross-bracing to two cricket grandstands for **Tweed Shire Council**. 50×50×5 RHS frames, fabricated in Brisbane and installed over the border.

Accessible ramp & stair balustrade

Two packages for **Melrose Built**: stainless handrail and balustrade to a compliant access ramp set out to the concreter's finished levels, and powder-coated balustrade with continuous graspable handrail to an internal stair flight.
